Speaker's Biography (provided by the speaker):

Ms Chew Yee Ling graduated with a Bachelor of Science (Hons) in Biochemistry and Microbiology from UPM. She is involved actively in the development of architectural paints and allied products. She is also involved in Continuous Process Improvement for the manufacturing of paints. She conducted many technical seminars on various aspects of architectural coatings for architects, developers, contractors e.g JKR, SIHAT, IJM, IOI Group, Metro Kajang, Gamuda, UEM and etc. She has hands-on experience on site trouble-shooting and very familiar with potential site issues relating to paints.

Professor Master David Koh is the founder of Malaysian Institute of Geomancy Sciences (MINGS) Malaysia. He is the Head of the Department of Geomancy Science in the Faculty of Architecture, Shanghai Jiao Tong University, Shanghai, China. He is also a practitioner, teacher and researcher of more than 35 years of study into the ancient Chinese science of Geomancy and I-Ching. He has given scores of talks on Feng Shui to various groups, organizations and professional bodies. Among them are Tourism Malaysia, DBKL, PAM, ISM, MIP, Malaysian Institute of Directors, Malaysian Institute of Management (MIM), Malaysian Society of Interior Designers (MSID), the Malaysian Heritage Society, banks and state government agencies. He has also presented papers on Feng Shui at local and international conferences like the Asia-Pacific Interior Designers Conference. He has written numerous articles in the press and is also a familiar figure, featured in both printed and audio visual mass media. He is possible the only Chinese Feng Shui master who has extensive knowledge on Muslim geomancy, called Tajul Muluk and Ilmu Ramal. He is a Feng Shui colour consultant to many companies, and has produced a Feng Shui colour paint chart, the first of its kind.

Ms Joe Choo Sook Lin has been practising Feng Shui since 2001. Currently she is the President of Malaysian Institute of Geomancy Sciences (MINGS) which was founded by Prof. Master David Koh in 1998. Being the President, her vision for the institute is to carry on Prof. Master David's teaching and visions. She is a co-writer of Prof. Master David Koh's series of the article on Klang Valley from the Feng Shui's perspective. This series of article appears on every Friday in The Star. She has been invited to appear on television and other media, such as on TV2 during the Chinese New Year programmes. She gives Feng Shui talks for banks and property related bodies, such as FIABCI - in the recent Asia Pacific Summit which was held in Kuala Lumpur and PAM. She conducts Feng Shui classes on a regular basis. Throughout these years, she has been assisting Prof. Master David Koh to attend to clients from various industries both within the country and abroad.
